- \Rightarrow Review your Safety Plan with all employees in January.
- ⇒ Communicate jobsite safety rules & expectations to workers, subcontractors, and visitors.
- \Rightarrow Ensure everyone understands them.
- \Rightarrow Review with all workers' their responsibility to follow the safety plan.
- ⇒ Conduct safety meetings regularly and follow up with additional information to reinforce what was covered.
- \Rightarrow Review emergency plan(s) and implementation processes.
- ⇒ It's everyone's job to report unsafe behavior. Report and/or document incidents or near misses.
- \Rightarrow Participate on your safety committee/team.
- ⇒ Be a resource for other workers, and help them make safe decisions.
